The Complete Policy Text

1.0 Privacy Policy

1.1 This Privacy Policy describes the way in which Metaprofiel b.v. (otherwise referred to herein as "we" or "us"), owner of the websites <http://www.mindsonar.com> and <http://www.mindsonar.info> (otherwise referred to as the "Websites") deal with the

information you provide to us and any other information we collect about you while you are visiting the Websites, to enable us to produce MindSonar Profile Reports based on your responses.

1.2 We will process any personal information provided to us (whether via the Websites or any other means) or otherwise held by us relating to you in the manner set out in this Privacy Policy.

1.3 By submitting your information to us and using the Websites you confirm your consent to the use of your personal information as set out in this Privacy Policy. If you do not agree with the terms of this Privacy Policy, please do not use the Websites or otherwise provide us with any personal information.

2.0 How we Protect Your Information

2.1 We employ best data collection, storage and processing practices and security measures to protect against unauthorised access, alteration or disclosure of your personal information, transaction information and data stored on our servers.

3.0 Sharing Your Information

3.1 We do not sell, trade, or rent your personal information to others.

3.2 We will share your information - in the form of one or more MindSonar Profile reports ("Reports") - with the MindSonar Professional ("MS Professional") whose MindSonar licence code you use before entering your information on the Websites. By entering your information on our Websites you confirm your consent to the use of your personal information for the Reports, as well as the sharing of the Reports with the MS Professional whose licence code you used.

4.0 Information Collected and How It Is Used

4.1 The information and data about you which we may collect, use and process includes the following:

4.1.1 information that you provide to us by filling in forms on the Websites, answering questions on the Websites or any other information you submit to us via the Website or email;

4.1.2 records of correspondence, whether via the Website, email, telephone or any other means;

4.1.3 details of your on-line behaviour on our Websites; and

4.1.4 details of your visits to the Websites including, but not limited to, traffic data, location data, weblogs and other communication data.

4.2 We may use your personal information and data together with other information for the purposes of:

4.2.1 generating MindSonar Reports;

4.2.2 complying with our legal and regulatory duties;

4.2.5 carrying out research and analyses. Research results will be anonymised, you will not be recognisable as an individual in the research papers.

5.0 Information Storage and Removal

5.1 We will take all reasonable steps to ensure that your information is kept secure and protected.

5.2 If you so request in an e-mail (to jh@iepdoc.nl) or in a written letter (to Metaprofiel b.v., Staringstraat 1, 6511 PC Nijmegen, The Netherlands), we will remove all the information we have about you as soon as possible, but at the latest within 30 days.

6.0 Use Of Cookies

6.1 We use cookies as a means of collecting information from a web server for the purpose of making it possible to continue your MindSonar session if your internet connection should temporarily fail. Cookies contain information that is transferred to your computer's hard drive.

6.2 By using the Websites you confirm your consent to receiving cookies. If you do not want us to play cookies on your system, please do not use the Websites.

6.3 If you want to delete any cookies already stored on your computer, you can do so by deleting your existing cookies and/or altering your browser's privacy settings to block cookies (the process you follow will differ from browser to browser). 7.0 Internet-based transfers
